Announcement of Joint Research Agreement with Stanford University's Department of Cardiothoracic Surgery

We are pleased to announce that Cuorips, Inc. and its U.S. subsidiary iReheart, Inc. have agreed to enter into a sponsored research agreement with the Department of Cardiothoracic Surgery at Stanford University School of Medicine. Joseph Woo, MD, is the Chair and Professor of Cardiothoracic Surgery.

Both parties have agreed to conduct a joint research program consisting of animal experiments in which an iPS cell-derived new product will be transplanted into the heart of a pig with myocardial infarction. Yasuhiro Shudo, MD, Clinical Assistant Professor of Cardiothoracic Surgery at Stanford, is the principal investigator for the project.

Through this research, data will be collected for use in submitting an investigational new drug application to the FDA, with the aim of conducting clinical trials in the United States.
